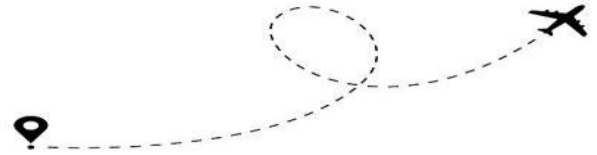
dines. It was SO SO FUN!

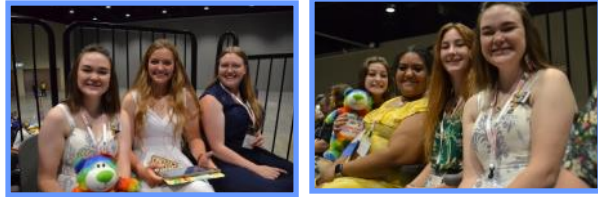

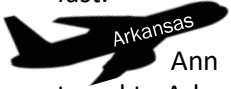

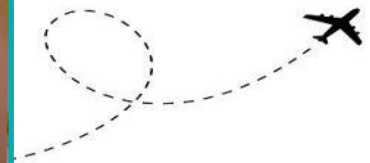
happened to be going to Supreme. Talking about Supreme, Colorado had a wonderful turnout. I am excited I was able to attend.
