Below is a summary of minimum requirements of eligibility.

**GLENN MONROE YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP AWARD APPLICATION**  
**PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP**

1. Applicant must be an **ACTIVE MEMBER** of either Job's Daughters, Rainbow for Girls or DeMolay
2. Applicants must be a permanent resident of Colorado, a Graduating High School Senior or currently attending an approved College.
3. The higher education institution (College) to which you plan on attending must be accredited through North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCA) OR the Trade School must be licensed.
4. They must be planning on attending an educational institution as **a full-time student**.
5. **Application must be completed, signed, and received by April 1st**. This is a Masonic Youth scholarship, therefore, in addition to scholastic achievement and need, considerable weighting for selection will be given to the level of activity and support the applicant has given to her or his Masonic Youth organization(s). The applicant does not have to attend a school in Colorado to be eligible for this scholarship.
