REGISTRATION RATES: (all rates are per person)

Full Registration includes rooms for 3 nights (Thursday, Friday, & Saturday). Thursday lunch and dinner, Friday breakfast, lunch, and dinner, Saturday breakfast, (brunch for GCC) and dinner, and Sunday breakfast. If someone is **not** registered for Full Registration, they can choose to attend the Grand Cross of Color Brunch (*if they have received their Grand Cross of Color*) and the Saturday night banquet for an additional cost. No other meals are available individually through registration.

RATES (*all rates are per person*)

- Full registration, Quad - room and meals \$380.00/ per person
- Full registration, Triple - room and meals \$450.00/per person
- Full registration, Double - room and meals \$510.00/per person
- Full registration, Single - room and meals Available upon request

A separate registration fee is required for anyone *not* registered for Full Registration if they plan to attend any Session other than the Sunday morning Installation.

Registration Only \$15.00/per person

The following pricing is for the Grand Cross of Color brunch and the Grand Banquet which includes the Registration fee above.

Grand Cross of Color Meal Only (Brunch).....\$30.00/person

Grand Banquet.....\$65.00/person

All Registration for Grand Assembly will be at the Rainbow Registration desk. Registration packets will be available to each participant upon arrival.

HOUSING: ALL ROOMS WILL BE REGISTERED THROUGH GRAND ASSEMBLY.

Please verify arrival date of ***all*** individuals. Rooms are normally available after 4:00 pm on your arrival date. Any late arrivals must be made known to Grand Assembly so that necessary arrangements can be made with the Hotel. If a registrant fails to check in on the noted arrival date, Grand Assembly cannot guarantee a room will be available.

We offer a special room rate for those wanting/needing to stay at the Hotel on Wednesday night. A room rate of \$174 per room will be honored for that night. If you want a room for this date, please complete the “*extra Wednesday night*” column on your registration form. This rate is priced by room, not by individual. We do ***not*** offer any other single room nights. If someone wants to stay on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday night, they will have to register as ***Full Registration***.

DUE TO THE RESTRICTIONS FROM SUPREME ASSEMBLY AND THEIR YOUTH PROTECTION, WE CANNOT HOUSE GIRLS AND ADULTS IN THE SAME ROOM UNLESS EVERYONE IN THAT ROOM IS RELATED.

NOTES TO ASSIST YOU IN FILLING OUT THE REGISTRATION FORM:

You must list ***everyone*** you are paying for on the housing form and pay accordingly.

We offer two (2) meals for those who are not registering for full registration. If someone is ***not*** registered for Full Registration, then they can choose to attend the meals listed below for an additional cost. No other meals are available through registration. A separate registration fee is required for anyone ***not*** registered for Full Registration planning to attend any Session other than the Installation.

1. The Grand Cross of Color Meal (Saturday Brunch)

- a. Only those who have received the Grand Cross of Color are eligible to attend the Grand Cross of Color meal and the Grand Cross of Color degree.
 - b. Breakfast and lunch for those not members of the Grand Cross of Color are also available during this same time.
2. The Grand Banquet (Saturday Dinner)

We must separate our meal count between those attending the Grand Cross of Color meal and those attending the General meal happening close to the same time. It is important to fill out the Grand Cross of Color information correctly.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

If one of your girls is seriously sick or injured, please call 911, then notify the Rainbow Nurse, who in turn will notify Rainbow Security.

An information easel will be located outside the Rainbow Registration room. Lost & Found will be at the Treasurers desk in the Assembly Room. If you need to contact the Grand Worthy Advisor for **any business** purposes, please see Angela DeSautell, Grand Deputy, and she will relay your messages to the Grand Worthy Advisor.

There is a pool at the hotel for the girls to use during free time. Please note that we **do not** have a lifeguard assigned and that the girls must be chaperoned while participating in this activity. See the dress code section on what to wear. One-piece or tankini type swimsuits are appropriate.

Dress Code for Grand Assembly

General Appearance

- Proper undergarments must always be worn and not be visible.
- Hosiery is preferred when wearing meeting or formal attire. "Yoga" pants or leggings **ARE NOT** considered hosiery.
- Dress shoes: Clogs, flip-flops, and athletic shoes **ARE NOT** considered "dress shoes."
- Body piercing jewels (other than earrings) should not be worn at Rainbow functions. There should be no visible tattoos.

Sessions (if you are being introduced or presented on the Grand Assembly Room floor) and Installation.

Grand Family Members will wear their Grand Dress for all Sessions. 2025-2026 Grand Officers may wear a Rainbow appropriate formal of their choosing for Installation.

Members and Adult Females

- Formal dress, floor, or ankle length.
- Strapless dresses are appropriate if worn with a shrug or shawl covering the shoulders.

- Halter, one strap, and two strap dresses are appropriate. Straps must be firmly attached to the dress.
- The front and back of any dress must be **solid** and rest at or above the natural bra line.
- Any slit in the dress may not exceed the knee.
- Avoid more than 50% of black and brown.
- Your choice must be considered tasteful and appropriate (not revealing in any way). If in doubt, think modesty.
- Dress shoes are preferred (any color, keeping in mind that white, silver, gold, or color to match the dress look best with pastel-colored dresses. If slippers are to be worn, **only** Ballerina slippers are acceptable.

Attire that is not appropriate: Revealing formals.

Males: Dress pants with dress shirt and tie. Jacket is preferred. Dress shoes are preferred (any color).

Sessions if you are NOT being introduced or presented on the Grand Assembly Room floor and Practices.

Members and Adult Females:

- Dress or skirt and blouse should be worn. Avoid more than 50% of black and brown. Your choice must look and be considered tasteful and appropriate.
- **For practices this year, girls may wear casual attire (pants/jeans WITHOUT ANY HOLES).**
- Length of dress or skirt should be **NO HIGHER THAN** two inches above the knee. Likewise, any slits shall be no higher than two inches (2") above the knee.
- Dress shoes are preferred (any color).

Attire that is not appropriate:

- Jeans
- Tight pants
- Split skirts higher than two inches (2") above the knee.
- Mini skirts
- Capris
- T-shirts
- Tube tops
- Bare midriffs
- "Yoga" pants or leggings

Males: Dress pants with dress shirt or polo shirt. Dress shoes are preferred (any color).

During free time and Outing:

- Pants, Jeans, Capris, Split skirts or shorts no higher than two inches (2”) above the knee may be worn. They must be worn at the waistline, have **no holes**, have a hem, and must be in good taste and appropriate.
- Shirts must contain no print that is offensive or controversial. Matching polo, T-Shirt, and Assembly or Grand Assembly t-shirts are appropriate and encouraged!

Attire that is not appropriate:

- Short shorts (Daisy Dukes)
- Tight jeans
- Sweatpants
- ***Pajama bottoms***
- Mini skirts
- Tube tops
- Bare midriffs
- Spandex shorts or pants
- “Yoga” pants or leggings.

Swimming Attire

- **Bathing suits may be one-piece or two-piece (preferably tankinis) providing the suit is in good taste and not revealing** (must cover the breasts and bottom). In hotels and other facilities, fingertip-length cover-ups and appropriate shoes must be worn when traveling to and from the pool and at NOCO Island.
- **Not appropriate:** Thong-type bathing suits or “string” bikinis.
